

The book covers a lot of old ground as these ballpark books do but the only things I found remotely interesting were some of the old photos that haven't been used in other publications. The book is literally 'thrown' together with a potted history of each old and new park, dimension and capacity information and interspersed with photos but it looks like it was rushed to meet a publishers deadline. It's worth 3 stars for many of the photos but it's not particularly inspiring in any other way.
