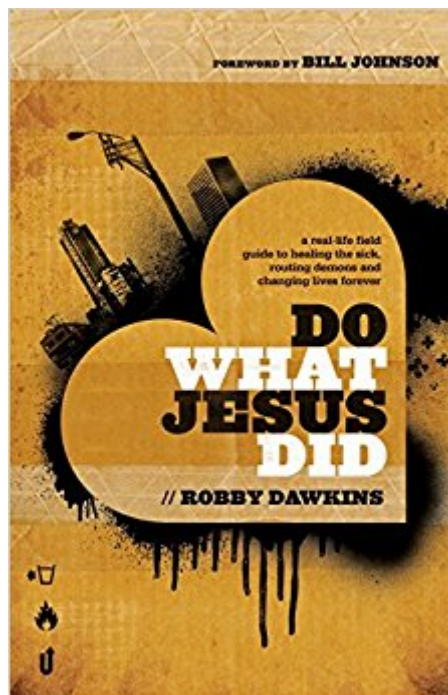

This book is a great mix of the writer's personal stories and teachings based on Scripture. It's not based on hype or just the "coolness" of seeing miracles; this book has a lot of substance when it comes to teaching why and how you can do the things Jesus did. Most importantly, it talks a lot about loving people and having a close relationship with God. It's an easy, fun read, that gains a lot of depth as you get further into the book. The writer is VERY real, not only talking about situations where he saw healing happening, but also the situations where he didn't (which is something many people experience and struggle with). I had seen some of Robby's videos before buying the book, and had been to one of his conferences, and I can tell you he's the real deal - God really uses Robby to stir up a hunger for God in people. I've been practicing what I've learned through Robby's teachings for about a year now, (even before getting this book), and have prayed for people in the streets and seen them healed, as well as 2 people in my family. It all comes down to how much you'll be willing to risk to do what Jesus did. My life has completely changed as I started practicing what I learned, and I can't help but want to tell everyone about how awesome it is to participate with God in what He likes to do. I just bought 10 more copies of this book to give to friends, and I'm sure I'll be buying even more copies as presents to others in the future. I definitely recommend this book!

In Mark 16 Jesus gives the church the Great Commission and the promise that healings and the miraculous would be accomplished through those who believe, all in one indivisible unit. So the last we heard from Jesus was, "Do this, and believe, and these things will happen." There is nothing in scripture that indicates this was ever supposed to change and man has no right to say that it has. But getting it back rolling again, it's tough to overcome both the spiritual opposition to it, our own doubts, and the traditions of man that dominates the Western church. When Goliath had everyone paralyzed with fear, David showed everyone how to kill a giant. That is what Robby is doing. He is one of the new pioneers in the Kingdom and is one of the ones who has done some of the hard work. Much from what I have learned from him I have been able to see God heal things in my

family, and now my children are commanding sicknesses to go and it is happening. I am not a kook, I was extremely skeptical and even when someone was healed I grilled them good to make sure it wasn't positive thinking or some baloney. If you want to cross the bridge from unbelief to having God work through you and your family to heal the sick, to the end of spreading the gospel and populating Heaven, you should get this book.

Those who do not believe that Jesus is the healer and who cringe and twitch and even screech when they hear that an average Joe can be used by God would find this book disappointing. Avoid this book if you are one who hates great healing testimonies, how-to books, seeing the miraculous in today's life, or one who hates hearing that drug dealers, gang members, and people who are possessed are being saved by Christ. Also, readers who are happy living with a religious spirit may find this read uncomfortable. Anyone who is not concerned about the fruit Dawkins is producing and is more concerned on policing "correct" interpretations of scripture is advised to not purchase this book, but get it on audio because it takes more effort to turn it off. But, then again, reading this book might change your mindset, so if you fall into any of these categories, check it out for yourself.
