This is the first book of this series to which I have given a poor rating, but it isn't actually because of the story itself. As I reflect on this series, I'm beginning to see that the light at the end of the tunnel truly is an oncoming train. When I found out that Episode 15 was going to be the end of the series, I let out a sigh of relief. Then, when #15 was announced, the description, "The Final Installment of SERIES 1" hit me like a ton of dark matter. The author thanks us for spending the last four years on this journey. That's fine, but I decided to draw the line at spending the next four years as a hapless reader seeking the Jung home world. And with no guarantee there wouldn't be yet another four years battling it out for final victory (assuming the series wouldn't end with some sort of an "it was all just a dream" ending). Several years ago, I worked in broadcast television and one of the things I learned about their soap operas was that, after getting into the story lines, you could take a hiatus for several months and when you started watching again you'd easily determine that you really hadn't missed a thing! This series seems to be not just a space opera, but a space soap opera. Maybe I'll check in when Mr. Brown gets to Episode 15 of Series 2.

First off, I HATE WRITING REVIEWS, but I know Authors need them to survive and make readers aware of their work, so you can rest assured that if I have posted any kind of review you will know that you have found a pearl that will enrich your reading experience beyond measure (at least in my view). My reviews do not dwell on the story line or the characters in the story, they just let you know that I found the story interesting, enjoyable and believe you will also, so be brave and pick up a copy, sit down and experience it for yourself just as I did. (I don't read other peoples reviews, before buying a book) That is all folks, the only other thing I can say is that I am looking forward to the next book from this Author as I really enjoyed this book.

Looking forward to Book 15. Wow, already 14 books published in this series and #15 promises to wrap up a story arc on this. Will be interesting to see where things go after Book 15 comes out. Many attempts by the Jung to capture the Jump Drive technology. One part in the book sticks in my mind ... one part not wrapped up. One question not answered. The new KVV's .. not all impacted in the battle they had .. and the question was asked .. "Did the self destruct work?" ... on those that missed. It was never confirmed .. so ... will the Jung capture one of these and get the jump drive technology they so sought. Read on all .. great series .. recommend to all.

I always hate to be the lone dissenter among my peers, but I believe a little perspective needs to be added to "The Weak and the Innocent" episode 14 of the Frontiers Saga by Ryk Brown. I have read the series from the beginning and as other fans eagerly await the next episode release. However, I feel the need to point out a few problems. Beginning with episode 12 the whole focus of the series has changed. What began as a story of maturity for the 4 main characters; Nathan, Jessica, Cameron and Vladimir the storyline completely switched gears bringing in new characters and lessening the role of the originals. Personally, I felt episode 12 was completely ridiculous and episode 13 completely changed Jessica's character, reduced Nathan's role, and killed off Tug just so his daughter would have an excuse to travel to Earth. Now we get the long awaited for Episode 14. Again the original characters appearance is reduced. Jessica becomes more of a cartoon character, Nathan and Cameron barely appear and Nathan (who has defeated up to ten battleships, battle platforms and cruisers across a 1000 light year span gets himself in a precarious position requiring rescue. Then there is the constant POV 10 to 15 paragraph shifts completely messing with the storyline and leaving several plot threads dangling making things more confusing. Peter F. Hamilton gets away doing POV shifts

by writing pages or even dedicating whole chapters, but a few incoherent paragraphs just doesn't cut it. Still, I anxiously await Episode 15 and hope it will swing back to the beginning and Jessica will be the cool calm operative, Nathan the combat genius, Cameron the voice of reason and Vlad, well Vlad.

This book is probably my 2nd favorite of the series because of all the stories before it all the side arches coming together to form cohesive lines ,it's like 5 different armies coming together and forming a true alliance and knowing the back stories of how it came to be, I don't know how many more books are planned but if the writing continues I could see another 10 to 15 books to finish it.. 5 out of 5 for me..

I hate Ryk Brown's books. Ok, I really just hate waiting months for a book that keeps me so enthralled that I read it in a day and a half then have to anticipate the next one. I found this to be the best so far of a really great series. "The Weak and the Innocent" kept me rapt from the first page until Nathan did an honorable thing for a Commander to do. Meeting with the family of a hero, Marine Sergeant Weatherly. The action was continuous and exciting. There were no lulls in any of this book.
