

In this book, Biscuit visits the pumpkin patch and makes some new friends while also getting a pumpkin. If you're familiar with the Biscuit books, you know these are simple stories. They are great for young children, and then when the child is a bit older, great for the child to practice their reading. I like this book very much because we are a family that loves Fall and all things Autumn, but we do not generally celebrate Halloween. I'm always on the lookout for Fall books that don't reference Halloween or Halloween themes. So this was a great addition to our collection.

This is a decent book but the idea is so simple it isn't that fun to read. My daughter enjoys the animals in it though.

I'll give this five stars based on my kid's fascination with it. I personally think the story is kind of bleh, even for a kid's book, but who am I to argue with the intended audience? The illustrations are great.
