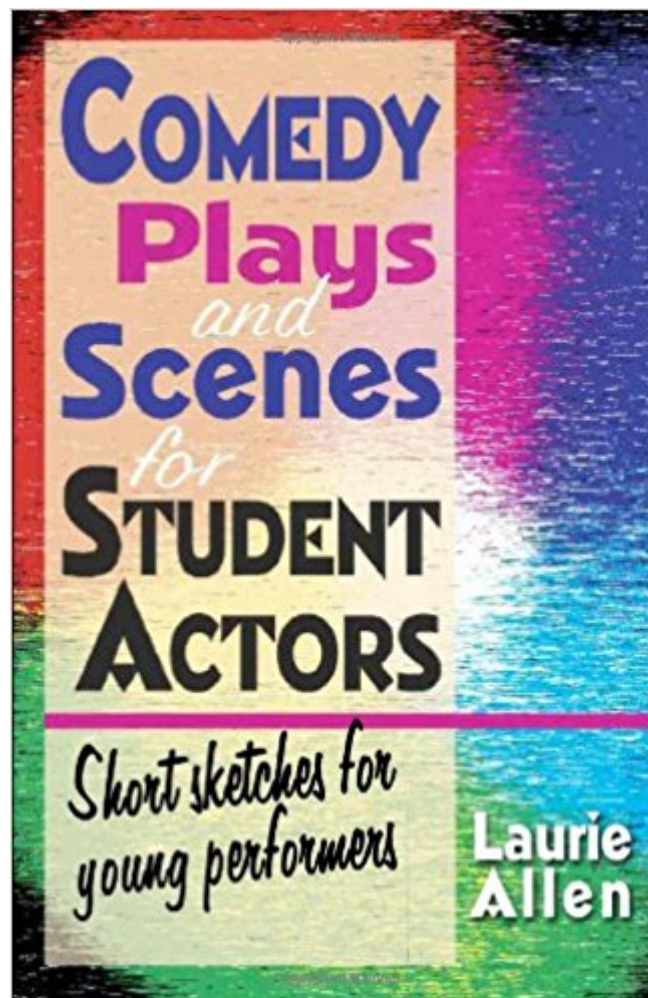

So, after graduating, she decided to combine her love for the theatre and her passion to write, and try her hand at writing a play. Her first play, *Gutter Girl*, won the Indian River Players One-Act Play Competition. At that moment she was hooked, knowing she had found the place where she belonged.
