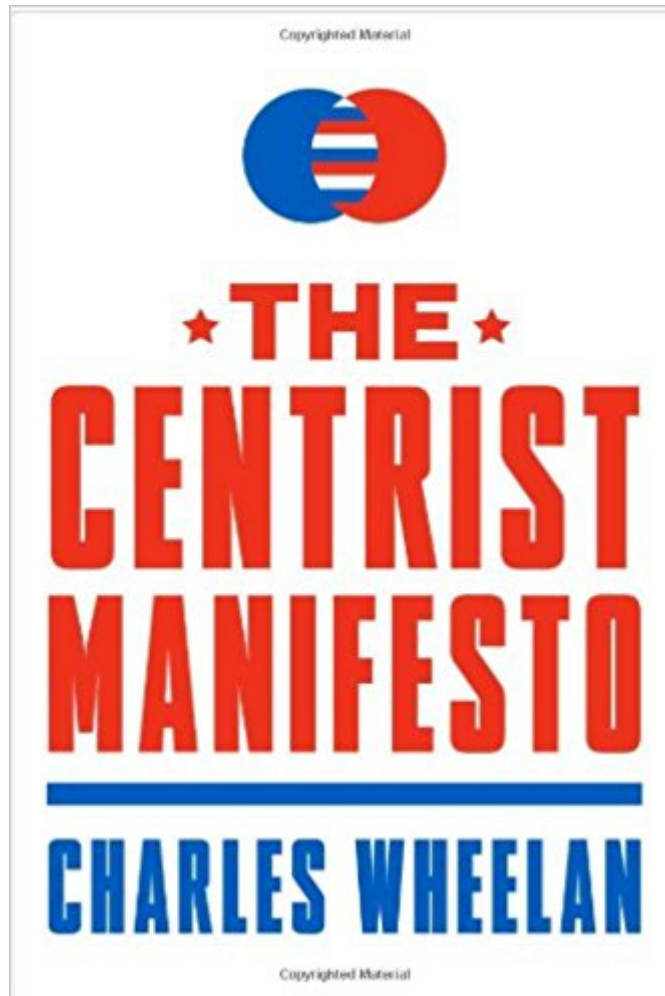




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The Centrist Manifesto

Charles Wheelan is the author of the best-selling *Naked Statistics* and *Naked Economics* and is a
