

We recently traveled to Peru for a 5-week tour mostly on our own. This guide book (along with tripadvisor) helped us solidify which places to stay, eat, and see before and during our stay. Highly recommend.

Excellent book....

Excellent travel information and up to date.

I can only speak to the part about Lima, as that's all I used. Overall, information was good and useful, with a few exceptions (below). My main beef, though, is that the index is really poor: if you want to find something you better remember where you saw it or you're out of luck. Please consider

adding at least 10-20 pages of index so that I can find a given museum or whatever. Some other notes for next time on Lima: 1) It would be great to have a map of the Metrpolitano system, preferably on the big map (currently on p.59). Also info about buying cards, etc. 2) Dates and times for Museo del Banco Central de Reserva del Peru (p. 64) need to be updated. The correct days and times are Tues, Thurs, Fri, & Sat 9-5 as well as Wed 9-7. 3) the Museo de Arte de Lima currently costs 30 rather than 12 soles. Well worth it IMHO! 4) I didn't see any information on the Metropolitan Museum of Lima[...]): not sure if that's by design. Maybe there's nothing there- I didn't have time to check it out. Again, overall this was a really useful reference: I was here for a few weeks for work and used the guide many times for reference, for finding the art markets, etc. It definitely did the job.

You always want at least 2 perspectives...and this is a good one.
