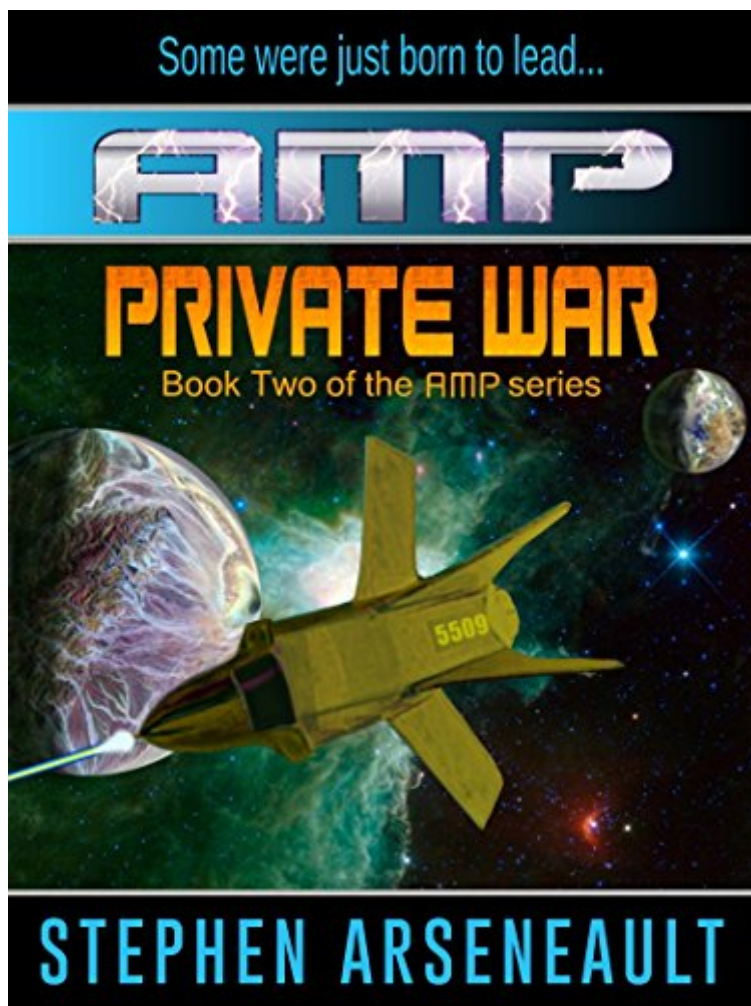




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AMP Private War

HADRON Series HADRON is a modern day story unrelated to the SODIUM-AMP-OMEGA trilogy series. After scientists using the Large Hadron Collider discover dark matter, the world is plunged into chaos. Massive waves of electromagnetic interference take out all grid power and forms of communication the world over. Cities go dark, food and water supplies are quickly used up, and marauders rule the highways. One group of citizens takes a stand. Can they make a difference? And the devastating EM waves, where are they coming from? After months of starvation, a benevolent species arrive in their spaceships to rescue the Human race. Only, are they really so benevolent?

ARMS Series ARMS is set in the future after Earth was nearing an apocalyptic event. Two competing colony ships were built, taking five million inhabitants each through a wormhole to a pair of newly discovered planets. The planets were settled and not long after the colonies looked to the surrounding star systems for ownership and expansion, which led to a centuries long war between them. A truce was declared after the aggressor side began to lose ground.

Tawnish Freely and Harris Gruberg are genetically engineered Biomarines. Their lives have been dedicated to fighting the war. They find themselves struggling to find work among a population that fears them. Work is found only by delving into the delivery of illegal arms to the outer colonies. Things go awry when they discover their illicit dealings may just be the catalyst that brings back the Great War. They are determined to prevent that from happening.

A good potato-chip read.

Private War picks right up where Messenger left off. Arseneault thankfully doesn't waste time re-hashing the entire last book. He understands that we read the first book and don't need to slog through 3 chapters of recap. The book continues its torrid pace, moving the plot in a way that keep you from ever feeling like the book is dragging, and the best part is that I never once read a paragraph and thought "I've already read this." There is no repetition, no filler, and it's really fun to read a book like this for a change. Small points for the author to consider: 1) Time management: There are a few times when you let large chunks of time pass like this "the next six months were largely uneventful," or "four months later..." Do NOT get flippant with large chunks of time. You can do this for a day, maybe even a week, but any longer and the reader goes "uh, what?" The problem is that so much can happen in a day in your books, so how can 6 uneventful months go by? 2) There were a lot more grammatical errors in this book. Not that I care much about that type of thing (See the 5 star rating), but it does feel like this book was a little more rushed than the first one, proofread

a little less. I have a mind that can fill in the word I knew you meant to type and ignore what's actually on the page, but to many readers this is a big issue. Be mindful of that. (If you want a cheap, yet awesome editor, hire me, I'll happily read your book and compile a list of grammatical and typographical errors as I go, would take me about 2 days to render your novel error-free)Keep up the good work!

I like the author's style, and the way he gets to the point on things. I was a little concerned at first, because some of the initial chapters were long on battle scenes, and I prefer a little more advancement of the story line, but maybe that's just me. I'm the type of person that when watching movies, I fast forward through long chase scenes or fight scenes because I get bored with them after a few minutes. Following the early fighting in the book, there seemed to be more plot and storyline advancement, and that got me back into the book. Again, I really liked this book, and the series and will continue on into #03, Blitzkrieg.

This space opera is captivating with fascinating characters, thrilling chases and narrow escapes. Grange is part Han Solo and part Katniss Everdeen. In this episode, the reader is introduced to new species and planets, new technologies and space weapons, and the rebels new home planet to-be. I read the Omega series first and recognize that those books can stand alone. Now I plan to reread them since I understand the myriad historical references. As with the previous books, I suspended my understanding of physics, macroeconomics, and cultural anthropology in order to enjoy the space battles, witty banter between characters, and subtle allusions to Terran politics and motivations. The next book is set up cleverly and I am ready to proceed!

This is truly an action packed series to read. I read the first two books and am currently reading the third and already bought the fourth. The story line keeps you interested. It has adventure and excitement yet it's not off the deep end with absurdity. Just when you think you've got it figured out the plot thickens and a new twist enters the picture. It is also written in a wholesome way that is refreshing to read. As I said, I'm in book 3 of this series and I haven't tripped across a single profanity yet the book and story line has spirit! Keep up the great writing Stephen Arseneault.

Stephen has an excellent way of telling a space story. Detailed action without getting boring in the battle scenes. Although the characters may not get fully developed as someone said there is enough variety in settings to keep the readers interest. The story moves at just the right pace for me

with some surprising developments. The kindle price of \$3.99 is a steal for the first two books of this series. I am going to purchase number 3 and will let you know (if you care) how that one goes.

The second book in the AMP series is probably better than the first. Things seem to be rolling along with our heroes gaining more income and weapons. Taking the hurt to the bad guys. Now that I have read the first two books in this series, I have to read the other 6. Great Space Opera! Come aboard the fight has just begun!
