

This book is very good for BASIC sectional and cross-sectional anatomical information. It is probably good enough for a Radiography Program's student Modalities Course, but may not contain enough in-depth cross-sectional information for anyone studying to become certified in CT. (NOTE: I myself am NOT certified in CT)

Very useful text.

Very difficult to correlate the line drawings with the blown-up grayscale CT slices, which just don't seem to look the same as the real thing. The Sagittal MR slices in chapter 2 are exceptionally difficult for the intended audience to follow. Factual and typographical errors occur throughout this text, such as identifying the vertebral foramen as the trachea on page 55. It seems like there could have been a better effort to develop the reader's understanding of 3D anatomy, rather than the brief review of freshman anatomy that is given. Instructors, please don't inflict this torture on your students.
