

John Milton's *Paradise Lost* is one of the greatest epic poems in the English language. It tells the story of the Fall of Man, a tale of immense drama and excitement, of rebellion and treachery, of innocence pitted against corruption, in which God and Satan fight a bitter battle for control of mankind's destiny. The struggle rages across three worlds-heaven, hell, and earth-as Satan and his band of rebel angels plot their revenge against God. For nearly 350 years, it has held generation upon generation of audiences in rapt attention, and its profound influence can be seen in almost every corner of Western culture.

John Milton (1608–1674) was an English poet whose blank-verse epic *Paradise Lost* is widely regarded as his masterpiece and one of the greatest epic poems in world literature. Simon Vance, a former BBC Radio presenter and newsreader, is a full-time actor who has appeared on both stage and television. He has recorded over eight hundred audiobooks and has earned five coveted Audie Awards, and he has won fifty-seven Earphones Awards from *AudioFile* magazine, which has named him a Golden Voice.

This reading of *Paradise Lost* is well done, though not terribly dramatic. Simon Vance is more than

competent, though he lacks the dramatic flair of Sir Anthony Quayle's reading of, sadly, only books I and IV.
