A great book of wisdom and thoughts for us to meditate on. It can be a little difficult to understand at times, if you don't know much about old world dialects, but leave your mind open to the words, and the meanings will come. Some of the wisdom is simple wisdom that serves more as a reminder. Some of the wisdom is simple wisdom that we tend to overlook. One such case, that I know I am guilty of doing is, 24. "The unwise man is awake all night, and ponders everything over; when morning comes he is weary in mind, and all is a burden as ever". The stanzas are all numbered, so it is easy to find bits of wisdom again. The words, although at times hard to understand as mentioned above, do tend to flow rather easily. You can go seamlessly from one stanza to the next, or read and focus on one stanza at a time. The physical book itself, is a little larger than I expected. It's not large by any means, and it does slip into my pocket easy enough. Not really a complaint, just a note. The print is clear and easy to read, with blank pages in the back for your own notes. Overall I would easily recommend this Havamal to anyone who, well, is anyone really. I've had a fascination with Norse mythology for a while, and recently decided it's time to get serious about learning about it. Even if you are not interested in Norse mythology, however, the Havamal is still a wonderful book to read, and for just 7 dollars, you are not taking a big risk with it.

Was instructed to buy this variant by another TAC member and I have not be sorry. I have read other versions of the Pocket Havamal and this one, by far, is the most poetic and easy to understand.
