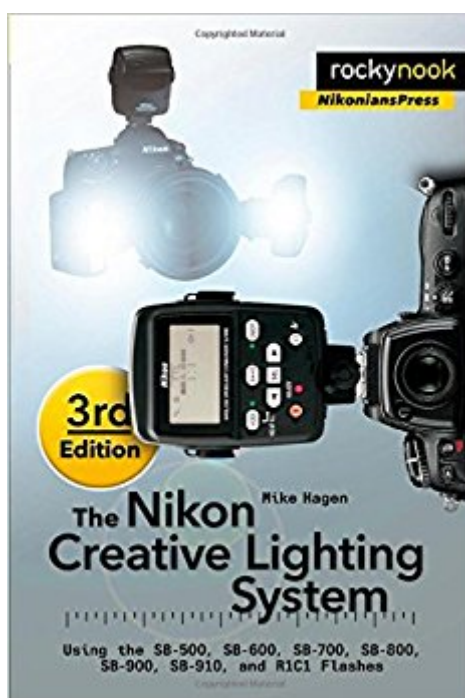

Great book on Nikon Speedlights. Actually a pretty quick read as well since the chapters on each model stand alone--no need to read the chapters on other models than what you have as the similar information is repeated in each. A lot of what I read applies to the Yongnuo radio triggers I decided to use instead of the Nikon infrared system as well.

Excellent. Covers Background, features a Quick Start Guide, Flash Theory and then goes into the specifics of the various Nikon Speedlights. Plenty of pictures showing the various effects. (Unfortunately I had a lot of misperceptions about flash photography prior to reading this.) The Capability of the Nikon Creative Lighting System is incredible, but the photographer must understand it to harness it for his or her benefit.

I received this book yesterday. Over the past couple of years I have bought and read two other books on the Nikon CLS system. This is BY FAR the best book on this subject. I learned more in the first hour or so with this book than anything else I have read. Everything is explained in a concise and easy to understand way , very well done!!!

After reading this book it was the first time that I really understood the Nikon CLS and now will be using it more as a addition to my landscape work particularly, in the early morning & late evening light, to add fill-in to the images. I strongly recommend this for anyone that is/or has benn confused about how the Nikon CLS works and how to use it.

In keeping with an earlier edition that I also owned, this 3rd edition is very well done and nicely

explains the Nikon CLS as well as other off camera flash methods available.

Pretty good stuff. Very useful knowledge that you might not just stumble upon by yourself-- and I've stumbled a lot... Covers a large number of Nikon flashes, so about half the book was of no use to me because I only have a single SB-900. This is much more a technical guide than a creative one; that said, I'd say start with the nuts and bolts.

I've only just begun reading this book so I can't give an informed opinion. So far, I like what I see.
