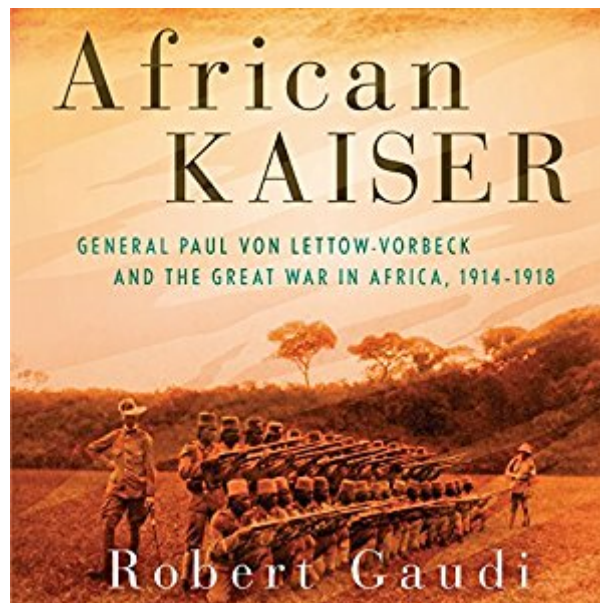




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African Kaiser: General Paul Von Lettow-Vorbeck And The Great War In Africa, 1914-1918

But mostly it is the story of von Lettow-Vorbeck - the only undefeated German commander in the field during World War I, and the last to surrender his arms in final defeat.
