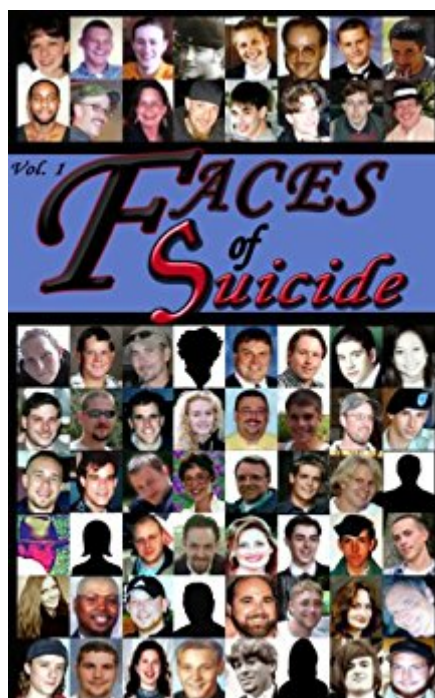

Reading personal stories from those of us that loved a victim of suicide will give a personal insight to the "out of sight, out of mind" topic and, hopefully, will educate the readers as to the struggle of the survivors that live with the outdated stigma that the word suicide carries with it. This is not a book that delves into the causes of suicide, rather it is a compilation of love stories. The love of a son, daughter, brother. sister, father. mother, husband or wife that have left too soon. It's a

book that puts a face on the statistics.
