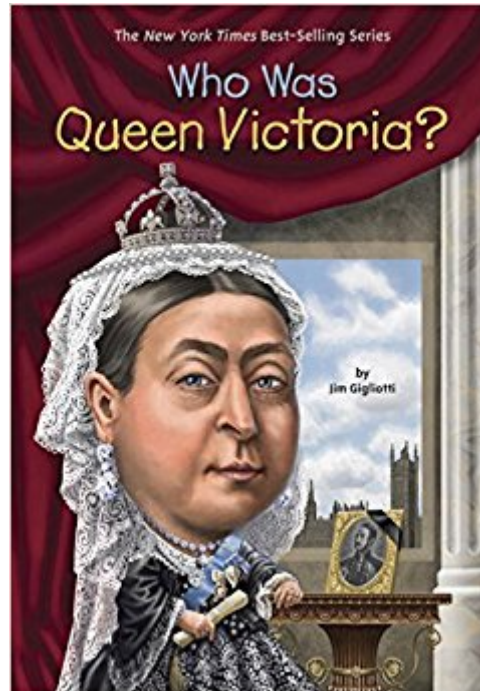

At six o'clock the next morning, though, Victoria's world changed. She woke up to hear her mother say that two men had arrived at the palace. They wished to see Victoria. The men were the archbishop of Canterbury and the lord chamberlain. The archbishop of Canterbury was the leader of the Church of England. The lord chamberlain was the top official in the royal household, where the king lived.
