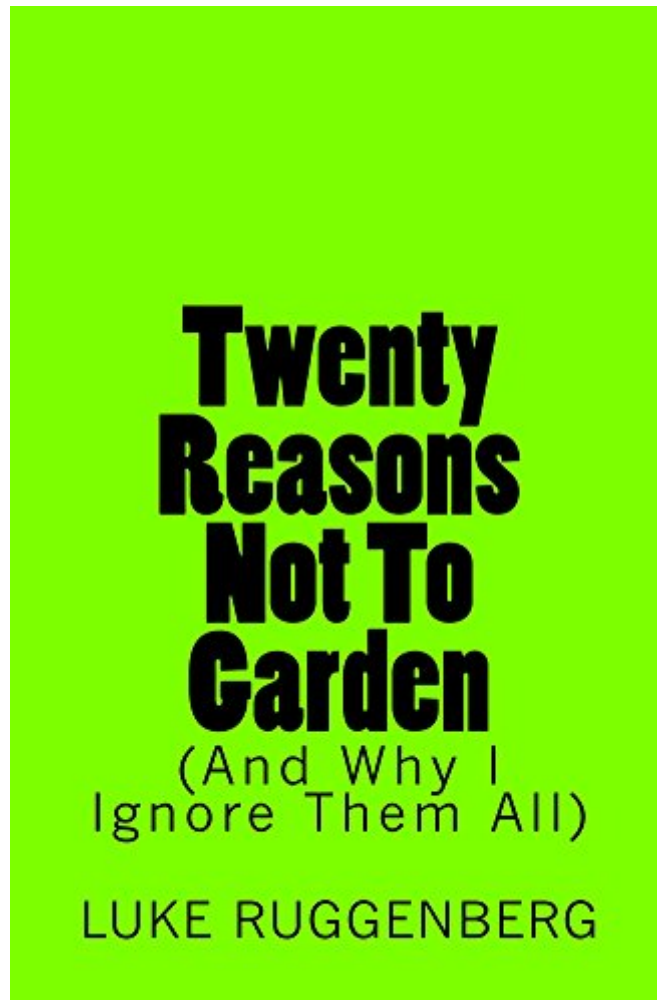

I love the humor of this writing, which is so unique for its genre. And the short chapters make it easy to pick up and enjoy at intervals.
