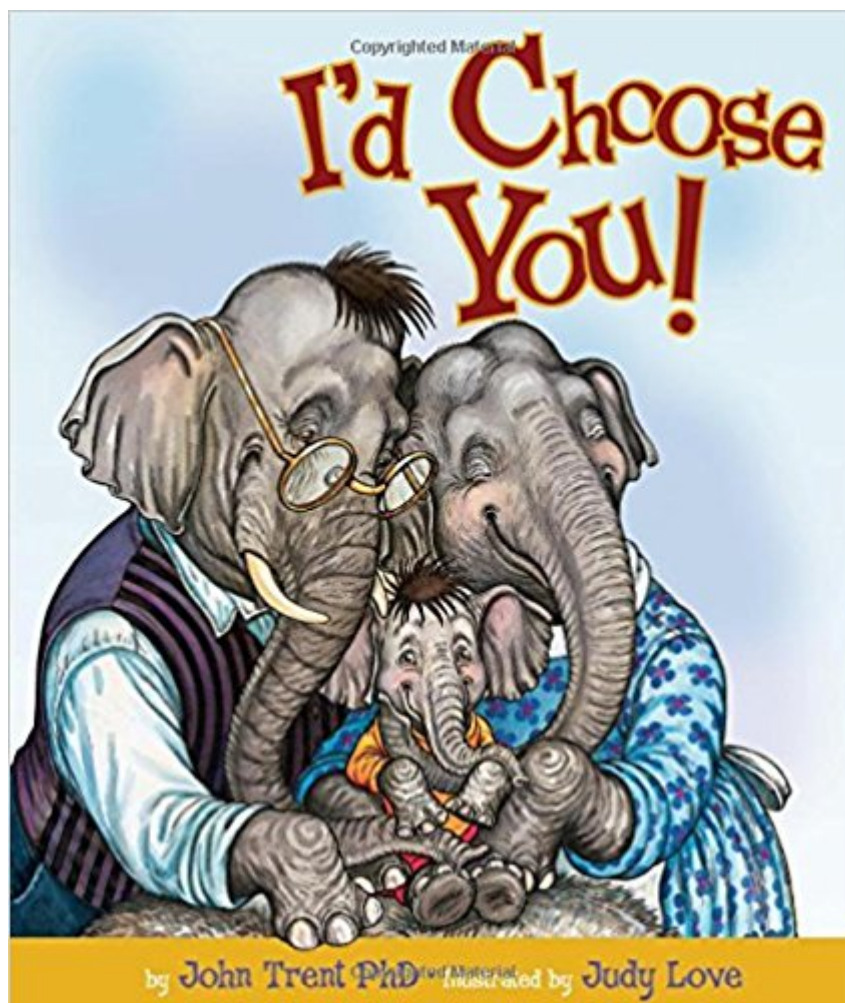


The book was found

To us, it seemed like it was a hard translation to a family with multiple children. Norbert had a bad day and his mom asks things like, "If I could use my arms to hug only one child, guess which one I'd choose," or, "If I could use my voice to cheer for only one child,

guess which one I'd choose."Not at all bad things to encourage a child with, but I can't help but think, if I read this to our Kid A, won't they be like, "But what about my sibling?" I'm just having a hard time seeing how to make it work for us. Maybe I'll read it a few more times and see if we could still use it somehow?Agreed with the theme and the message, this particular delivery of it just wasn't what we were looking for.I do *highly* recommend the book "The Blessing" by the same authors... incredible resource. (Not a children's book- one for the parent to read and learn)
