I just wanted to let folks know that cleaning the iClicker 2 with alcohol is not a good idea around the screen. Rubbing alcohol will create a permanent haze over the screen for some reason. Use windex instead. I have remedied my hazy screen by using RainX on it. Once buffed, it will look like normal again. (The instructions didn't include a way to clean it.)

Good clicker, seems sturdy enough and haven't had a problem with it yet.

It shipped a couple weeks late, but otherwise I have no complaints about this iClicker!

This is definitely one of the better looking iClicker compared to the older versions. Although I don't see much of a difference based on its functions but nevertheless it did its job. I used it for a lecture for college and it was light in weight and easy to use. The set up was easy too. It came with its original box and plastic bubble wrap which was a plus because it kept my iclicker from scratches.

I don't have anything special to say about this. The product does exactly what it's supposed to. I

think requiring it in classes is stupid, but this isn't the place to complain about that. Lasted the entire semester with no issues. I keep it in the bubble wrap inside the box. Comes with batteries, which I haven't had to change.

Required for most of my college classes, but it's easy and simple to use! You just need 2 AAA batteries for it to work and there is a list of instructions on the back on how to operate the clicker. It's also fairly small (about half an inch longer than an iPhone 6s), so you can fit it in one of the small side pockets of your backpack.

Used this not three weeks in one class and it mysteriously dies forever. I put it in my desk, it has a case, never dropped or scratched it...waste of my money. Tightened the screw, replaced batteries with energizer, the whole ordeal to reset these. My class requires this and it's ridiculous, since iclicker is known to be faulty. I will not be buying from or this brand, instead I'll just buy used, since they break either way, at least used you don't put more money in their pockets they clearly do nothing useful with.
